ST. DAVID'S DAY SCHOOL ADDITIONAL PROGRAMMING

Starting with the Fall 2017 school year, St. David's Day School will offer two afternoon programs. The afternoon programs will be available to children ages 3 and up enrolled at the Day School who are toilet trained. (Early morning drop off also is available to children in the 2's program.)

St. David's teachers Margie Szymkiewicz and Tina Protzman are our co-directors for afternoon programming. At least one co-director will be staffing the daily Enrichment Program along with assistance from a Day School Teacher. Tina and Margie bring a wealth of knowledge and experience to the school's extended programming. Margie's educational background includes bachelor's and master's degrees in education from Loyola University. She taught for nine years in the Montgomery County Public Schools. Margie has been teaching at St. David's for a total of nine years and has been in her current position as a Kindergarten teacher for five years. In addition to her experience in the classroom, Margie is the parent of four former St. David's students! Tina has a bachelor's degree from the University of Baltimore and is certified in Child Growth and Development, Preschool Curriculum Activities, and Infant and Toddler Care. She has taught at the Little Friends Extended Day Program and as a substitute in the Baltimore County Public Schools' special education classrooms. Tina, who teaches in the 3 year-olds' classroom, has been at St. David's for three years.

Lunch Bunch, which runs from 12 noon – 2:45 pm, is a multi-age program centered around indoor and outdoor free play, lunch, and story time. A new Enrichment Program will run from 2:45 – 5 pm. This program will have a daily enrichment activity. Each week there will be activities on the topics of Spanish, Literature, Science and Math, Geography and Cultures, and Art. Families will have the option to participate in one or both programs. A short rest time will be incorporated for those children staying for both.

Early Morning Drop Off Hours: 8 am-8:45 am
Daily Rate: \$7, paid directly to teacher on duty

Lunch Bunch Hours: 12 noon-2:45 pm
Daily Rate: \$25
Number of Openings: 16
Bring lunch. Milk is provided.

Afternoon Enrichment Hours: 2:45-4 pm, or 2:45-5 pm
Daily Rate: \$15 per day until 4 pm
\$25 per day until 5 pm
Number of Openings: 16
Bring lunch and snack. Milk is provided

- If late for picking up your child from Lunch Bunch or Afternoon Enrichment, you will be charged the additional cost until the next pick-up time (e.g., If late for a scheduled 4 pm pick-up, you will be charged \$10 more, which is the additional cost for 5 pm pick-up). After 5 pm, the late charge will be \$1 per minute.

Contracted Use:

Contracts for Lunch Bunch and Afternoon Enrichment will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Contracted students will be guaranteed a place on the daily sign-up sheets as standing reservations. **Parents must pay for standing reservations regardless of their child's attendance unless there is an emergency school closing or their child must leave before the afternoon programming due to illness.** Monthly bills will be distributed at the beginning of each month. Payment is due upon receipt of your monthly bill.

Contracted discount: 10% discount for students contracted at least 3 days per week.

Occasional Use:

Lunch Bunch and Afternoon Enrichment day passes are available for purchase in the office. Once purchased, occasional users may sign up on posted daily sheets outside the school office. Finalize your plans before you sign up to avoid being charged for a day you don't use. **If your child's name is on the sheet after 9 am on the day of use, you will be charged. Payment (either in the form of the prepaid pass or with cash/check) is due the day your child attends. No refunds unless there is an emergency school closing or a child leaving before the afternoon due to illness.** If you need to cancel your reservation, you must notify the office by 9 am the day of the service. 3/21/17
